# CHAMPIONSHIP

---

- Every participator must be acquainted with all regulations, properly registered into championship and signed up to every race event
- ČSautoslalom 2021 championship consists of 9 race events and driver's best 7 races are taken into account (2 worst races/absences are ignored)
- Cars are divided into 10 classes depending on modifications and engine size
- 8 best drivers of every class and 15 best drivers of overall ranking score in each event
- ČSautoslalom 2021 champions of every class and of overall ranking will be announced in the end of the series



# SCHEDULE

---

- 1x Practice run
- 3x Competitive run  
(2 best runs are taken into account – worst run is ignored)
- Exact schedule is placed on every event's website



# DRIVER

---

- Driver's minimal age is 15 years (all under-age drivers must have their legal representative's approval and LR must be present at the event)
- No more than 3 drivers may compete in single vehicle
- There may be one passenger present in vehicle during the race, unless he/she is not also competitor (on Násedlovice track are passengers forbidden completely)
- Driver participates on his/her own responsibility and by signing up takes full responsibility for all damages to the health or property caused by his/her actions and will not assert any claims or damages from the organizers (Exception: fund insurance; section registration and starting fee)



# REGISTRATION AND STARTING FEE

---

- Obligatory online registration into championship at [www.csautoslalom.cz](http://www.csautoslalom.cz)
- Obligatory online application into every event at [www.csautoslalom.cz](http://www.csautoslalom.cz)
- Starting fee for 1 event: 1 000 Kč / 40€
- Cash payment at the event during registrations
- In the price is included fund insurance against track equipment or organizer's equipment damage (safety barriers, signs, fences, gates and timekeeping device,...). The insurance does not apply at damages to the driver's health or property or damages to the health or property of third party.



# RACING VEHICLE

---

- Vehicle = car
- Technical inspection for road traffic is not obligatory, but vehicle must fulfill basic safety standards
- Technical commissioner supervise vehicle's condition, performs inspections and sort vehicles into classes
- Vehicles are sorted into divisions depending on modifications





# CLASSES

- Depending on modifications and specifications, vehicles are sorted into 4 divisions, which are divided into classes according to size of engine

# TECHNICAL REGULATIONS - STOCK

---

- S division is designated for pure stock cars with valid Technical Inspection

**Only these** modifications are allowed:

Interior – Seat belts and steering wheel may be replaced with sport types. Front seats may be replaced with sport (“E” type Homologation) or racing (FIA homologation, may be expired) types. Emergency tool kit may be removed.

Exhaust – Tailpipe may be replaced.

Tyres and wheels – Stock / Road legal Semi-slick (Homologation “E”). Wheel size may not comply to TP/certificate of roadworthiness



# TECHNICAL REGULATIONS - SPORT

---

- SP division is designated for vehicles with TP/certificate of roadworthiness

**Only these** modifications are allowed:

Interior – Seat belts and steering wheel may be replaced with sport types. Front seats may be replaced with sport (“E” type Homologation) or racing (FIA homologation, may be expired) types. Additional features on dashboard are allowed. Rear seats, cargo cover, door panels and emergency tool kit may be removed.

Bodywork – No more than one body part may be replaced with lightweight version.

Chassis – Modifications / replacements of suspension are allowed (shocks and springs with different characteristics and lower ride height). Strut bars are allowed.

Brakes – All brake calipers, pads and discs are allowed.

Engine – Modifications of air intake and exhaust manifolds (not replacing), ECU’s and components within cylinder head are allowed. Replacement of engine block is allowed if it is block produced by the same manufacturer for the same or similar type

Steering – Modification / replacement of steering box is allowed.

Transmission – Replacement of final drive gear and replacement / fitting of differential are allowed.

Tyres and wheels – Stock / Road legal Semi-slick (Homologation “E”). Wheel size may not comply to TP/certificate of roadworthiness

**All other modifications (lightweight body, interior parts removal different than above, slick tyres, roll cage, aerodynamic modifications,...) are in SP division forbidden.**

# TECHNICAL REGULATIONS - RACING

---

- R division is designated for vehicles modified beyond S and SP division standards
- All modifications are allowed (except specifics for Supercars), including tyres of driver's choice and tyre warmers



# TECHNICAL REGULATIONS - SUPERCARS

---

- Division SC is specifically determined for:

„Open-wheel“ cars with uncovered wheels (for example Caterham type)

Cars with tubular construction

Cars of „Radical“ type

Cars with modifications exceeding divisions S, SP a R

(formula, karts, buggy and quads are part of supercars class but they are out of the absolute ranking)



# TEAM TROPHY

---

- One of team members must register team into championship
- There should be included: name of the team, manager and 4 drivers (drivers can not be changed during the season)
- In each race, two drivers with the most points take team points
- Team's point count of event is a sum of points acquired by members during event in their classes
- Team Trophy is evaluated only in the end of the series. Overall ranking of championship is determined by sum of acquired points during events. All events are taken into account during evaluation of Team Trophy



# STARTING NUMBERS AND TIMEKEEPING

---

- Driver has one set of starting numbers for whole ČSautoslalom 2021 series
- Starting numbers must be visible on both sides of vehicle
- Doublers must keep at least 10 minutes break between one vehicle's runs (apply for division S and SP)
- Starting numbers are sorted by classes

# RESULTS

---

- Overall ranking is based on sum of time in 2 best runs of event. If several drivers achieved same sum of times, fastest run decides.
- 3 best drivers of overall ranking and 3 best drivers of every class are announced after every event.
- According to results in overall ranking of each race points are awarded by following scheme:

- In each class:

POINTS	10	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

- If several drivers achieved same sum of points, highest number of first, second, third,... places in each races decides.





# PENALISATION

---

- Time of run + penal seconds are taken into account during evaluation of each run

<b>KNOCKING DOWN OR DISLOCATION OF CONE</b>	2 SECONDS
<b>MISSED GATE</b>	20 SECONDS
<b>DISREGARD STOP SIGN</b>	20 SECONDS
<b>DISREGARD RED FLAG</b>	DISQUALIFICATION
<b>RERREATEDLY DISREGARD STOP SIGN</b>	DISQUALIFICATION



# SAFETY

---

- Driver and passenger must have fastened their seat belts and must have helmet on during all runs
- On the track vehicle must have closed doors and windows near driver and passenger
- Driver must comply with flag signals and organizer's orders
- It is forbidden to enter the racing track without permission. Drivers, passengers and viewers may visit pit lane and designated area only.
- Racing or hobby overall is highly recommended during all runs and also during announcement of winners.



# SIGNALS AND BEHAVIOUR ON TRACK

---

- Red flag is signal for immediate stopping of vehicle for safety reasons
- If had to end his/her run because of red flag, driver has right to repeat the run
- It is forbidden to stop, reverse, turn around and open doors or windows on the track, without authorization from organizers
- If stops on the track and is unable to continue, driver will turn hazzard lights on and wait for organizers to arrive. If vehicle stops on dangerous site, driver has to leave the vehicle, walk away from the track and wait for organizers on safe spot.



# PIT LANE

---

- Pit lane is marked in track plan of each event
- Maximum speed outside of racing track is 20 km/h
- Driver takes full responsibility for his/her actions and actions of passenger and team members. Driver keeps the site clean and everything he/she brought along (including garbage) has to carry away.



# PROTESTS

---

- Only driver can make a protest against other driver or vehicle always just at current event
- Protests must be solved until the end of event in which it was made
- Race director makes verdicts.



# AGREEMENT

---

- Driver participates in events on his/her own responsibility and by signing up takes full responsibility for all damages to the health or property caused by his/her actions and will not assert any claims or damages from the organizers
- Driver will obligate all terms, conditions and rules of ČSautoslalom championship
- It is forbidden for driver or passenger to be under influence of alcohol or drugs during the event.
- Driver acknowledges that he/she participates at his/her own risk, will adjust speed of vehicle and behavior whatsoever to his/her own abilities, experiences and weather and other conditions. Driver's priority is his/her own safety and safety of others, not the best results
- Driver acknowledges that there are no fire and ambulance services present at ČSautoslalom events. If necessary these services will be provided by standard 112 call.



# EPILOGUE

---

- Considering inability to note all circumstances, race director's decision is superior to these rules.
- Organizer has right to alter schedule and calendar of championship.
